2. Privacy Statement

This Privacy Statement applies to all data collected by **Detours Zürich** in connection with the use of this website and/or the services provided by Detours Zürich (in particular, walking tours & team events).

By accepting this Privacy Statement, you agree to the processing of your data by Detours Zürich in compliance with this policy. This Privacy Statement is subject to change. Please review it periodically for updates. The most recent version will always be available on our website.

3. Purposes for Which Personal Data is Processed

We process your data for the following purposes:

- **Booking, payment, and service provision** (including communication regarding your booking and tour updates).
- Website analytics & statistics to improve user experience.
- Quality management (e.g., improvement of our website and offers).
- Marketing & communication
- Sharing photos/videos on social media for promotional purposes (see Section 10: Use of Photos & Videos).
- Legal & accounting compliance (e.g., tax records).

Data Retention Periods:

- **Booking & payment data:** Retained for 10 years (as required for accounting & legal compliance).
- Website usage data: Retained for 12 months (for analytics & service improvement).
- **Photos/videos on social media:** Stored indefinitely unless a removal request is received.

4. Legal Basis for Data Processing

We comply with Swiss Federal Act on Data Protection (FADP) and the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) where applicable.

5. Sharing of Data with Third Parties

We collaborate with third-party service providers that have access to your data:

- Payment processing: Payrexx AG (Privacy Policy)
- Web analytics: Google Analytics (anonymized data)
- Website development: Spacek Digital (Privacy Policy)
- Email services: Microsoft 365, Gmail
- Social media platforms: Facebook, Instagram (if photos/videos are shared)

International Data Transfers: Some providers store data outside of Switzerland/EU. We ensure that Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs) or equivalent safeguards are in place.

6. Information Uses

We use your personal information to:

- Process and manage your bookings.
- Measure interest in and improve our services.
- Notify you about offers.
- Communicate tour updates & respond to inquiries.
- Publish your reviews, ratings, photos, and videos.
- Customize your website experience (e.g., language settings).
- Send surveys/feedback requests.

7. Data Processing in Connection with the Booking, Payment, and Use of a Service

Processing your data is necessary for the provision of our services (in particular, the organization and execution of walking tours & team events). When you book an experience with us, we will process the following personal data: **first name, last name, email address, telephone number, country of residence, and payment method.** This data is required for booking confirmation and attendance checks before the tour starts.

For online payments by credit/debit card, payment details are required for processing. However, Detours Zürich does not process or store your credit/debit card details. Payments



are handled directly through our established payment provider, Payrexx AG. The privacy policy of Payrexx AG applies.

Detours Zürich does not assume any liability for the processing of your payment data or compliance with data protection laws by the respective payment provider.

8. Data Security

We take appropriate security measures to protect your data from unauthorized access, loss, or destruction, including:

- **SSL encryption** for website transactions.
- Access controls (data only accessible by authorized personnel).
- Regular security audits and penetration testing.

Email security: Emails and booking forms are not encrypted. Please avoid sending sensitive data via email.

Data Breach Notification: In the event of a data breach, we will notify affected individuals and authorities within 72 hours (as required under GDPR).

9. Cookies & Website Tracking

We also use cookies on our website. Cook-ies are small files that are stored on the computer of the users when they use our website. Cookies will allow us to recognize your browser at the next session. AnalyNc cookies will help us understand how our website is used, so we
